Thank you for choosing Carrollwood Village Dental. Our primary mission is to deliver high quality comprehensive dental care. An important part of that mission is making the cost of optimal care as easy as possible by offering several payment options.

Please note: Carrollwood Village Dental requires payment at the start of your treatment.

We accept: Cash, Check, Visa®, MasterCard®, Discover®, or American Express®

Payment Options:

1. Pay in Full Discount - 10% discount will be applied to treatment plans paid in full prior to beginning treatment.
2. Two Installments - 70% due at the start of treatment, and the final 30% due at the completion of treatment. (Only for treatment that will require more than one visit)
3. CareCredit - Start treatment today with 0 down and make interest free payments for 6, 12 or 18 months. No annual fees or pre-payment penalties.¹

Please note:

- As a courtesy for patients with dental insurance, we will directly bill the insurance carrier for reimbursement for your treatment.² Your Estimated Patient Portion will be collected at the beginning of your treatment.
- We do our best to provide an accurate estimate of insurance coverage, but due to the complexity of the plans sometimes an additional co-pay will be due after your claim is processed. If applicable, we will mail you a statement once we receive the claim's explanation of benefits.
- Carrollwood Village Dental charges our Bank Fee for returned checks (in addition to the fee for treatment rendered).
- We respectfully request at least 48 hour notice for cancellations or rescheduling appointments.
